The Grameen Bank is a microfinance organization and community development bank that offers small loans to impoverished people without demanding any collateral. As a research project of Prof. Muhammad Yunus who wanted to design a credit delivery system providing banking services targeted to the rural poor, the bank started 1976 in Bangladesh. In 1983, the project was transformed into an independent bank by government legislation. In 2006 the organization and its founder, Prof. Yunus, were finally awarded the Nobel Peace Prize.

Business Objective:

The Grameen organization - nowadays consisting of numerous partner organizations - has already experienced the quality of Bosch conference systems within different buildings of its organization such as the Grameen trust building or the Grameen Shakti building. In these buildings Bosch's CCS 800 Ultra Discussion System had been installed.

For the building of Grameen Bank, the head office of all other organizations, a similar solution was looked for.

Solution:

Again, Bosch's CCS 800 Ultra Discussion System turned out to be the perfect solution for the organization's needs.

Consequently, an overall of 30 delegate units, one chairman and one central control unit have been finally installed in Grameen Bank.

The CCS 800 Ultra Discussion System which brings order and convenience to small and middle-sized gatherings and conferences is simple to install and extremely straightforward to use. Moreover, it has all the facilities required for achieving full control of meetings and discussions without the need for any operator. The system can also be easily extended and provides ease of use for every of its various functions.

Additionally, the CCS Control Unit is even able to supply the power for up to 150 delegate and chairman units in the system as well as the connection for audio inputs and outputs.

The system's special features include: a built-in MP3 recording to digitally record, the possibility of discussion to an SD card, playback with graphical display, a patent-pending recording buffer and a built-in monitor loudspeaker. Through digital acoustic feedback suppression acoustic feedback ("howling") can be even automatically eliminated.

The CCS Delegate Unit on the other hand provides a microphone with flexible stem. Thus, it can be easily adjusted in order to suit personal preferences. It even allows two people to share one delegate unit in a meeting. All of the delegate units also have a built-in control for headphones.

In addition to those functions of the CCS Delegate Units the CCS Chairman Unit possesses a priority button that can be pushed to mute all delegate microphones. For preceding the chairman priority calls, an optional chime tone can be selected.
